

JAM International Higher Student Scholarship (Non-EU citizen)

Applicable study: Non-EU students of the Jam Music Lab Private University who are in the 2nd study year or higher with:

- an average grade of at least 1.5 in the Principal Instrument (Module 1)
- an average grade of at least 2 in all other courses
- the required minimum number of ECTS credits
- a scholarship from Jam Music Lab GmbH

in the course of the preceding academic year.

- Closing date: May 15 and July 1 (for fall term)
December 1 and February 1 (for spring term)
- Tenure: Two Semesters
- Number on offer: up to 10
- Offer rate: each semester
- Value: up to EUR 3,250.00 per semester for two consecutive semesters

Description

The Scholarship was established in 2021 and is funded by the holding company of the JAM MUSIC LAB Private University, JAM MUSIC LAB GmbH.

The main purpose of the Scholarship is to support enrolled degree students in their further course of their studies at JAM MUSIC LAB Private University.

Selection Process

Application is made to the Student Service Centre. It must be a single file in PDF format containing:

- a **letter of motivation** that provides information about the specificity of one's own artistic work, one's personal background in relation to artistic creation and one's artistic-personal development (at least 3.000 characters),
- a written, detailed (at least 1.500 characters) **statement indicating the student's financial situation**¹ and
- an **audiovisual presentation** of the applicant's personality and artistic performance (not older than half a year).

A selection committee comprising a member of the Rectorate of the JMLU and two teachers nominated by the Rectorate assesses the applications. The Scholarship is awarded by the Chief Executive of the holding company of Jam Music Lab Private University on the recommendation of the Selection Committee.

The Selection Committee may deviate from the above grade requirements in justified exceptional cases. Justified exceptional cases include the following

- special financial hardship of the requesting student, which endangers the continuation of studies²

or

- a previous course of study that, while not yet meeting the required grades, indicates exceptional artistic potential. This must be documented by two reports from JMLU teachers with an explanation of why the previous grade point average has not yet been achieved.

Regulations

1. The Scholarship will be known as the JAM International Higher Student Scholarship.
2. The scholarships will be awarded each semester, and will be of the individual value of up to EUR 3,250.00 per semester for each student in the 2nd study year or higher.
3. The Scholarship may be awarded to a full-time student entering study towards a degree (diploma or educational diploma).
4. The Scholarship is tenable by international (non-EU) students.
5. The basis of selection will be artistic achievement and/or potential as assessed by the Scholarship Committee and in exceptional cases demonstrated financial need.
6. The Award will be made by the Chief Executive of JAM MUSIC LAB GmbH upon recommendation of a Selection Committee comprising a member of the Rectorate of the JMLU and two teachers nominated by the Rectorate.
7. The Scholarship will be credited towards the study fee of the next two semesters of an awardee. Cash payout is not possible.
8. The amount and number of scholarships depends on the economic situation of Jam Music Lab GmbH. It is not obligated to award scholarships even with complete application documents and recommendation by the selection committee.
9. The Scholarship may be held concurrently with any other scholarship, award or grant as long as a) the terms of that scholarship, award or grant permit and b) JAM MUSIC LAB GmbH is informed and approves.
10. JAM MUSIC LAB GmbH has the power to amend or vary these regulations provided that there is no departure from the main purpose of the Scholarship.
11. Applications close with the Student Service Centre on May 15 and July 1 (for fall term) and December 1 and February 1 (for spring term).
12. Notes [I]–[II] below are deemed to be Regulations.

Notes

I. Payments under the terms of this Scholarship remain tax-free as long as they are used directly for the payment of costs associated with an awardee's program of study. Failure to comply with this regulation will result in the termination of the Award.

II. Recipients of a Foundation Scholarship will be required to give undertakings that they will comply with the regulations for the Scholarship and will notify the Student Service Center of any change in their enrolment or funding status. JAM MUSIC LAB GmbH may, in the event that it can be established that a recipient of a Foundation Scholarship is not complying with these regulations, terminate the Scholarship and require repayment of the funds received from the date of the breach.
