

## Call for merit scholarships

Academic year 2020/21

Merit scholarships serve to recognize outstanding academic achievement. The funds are provided by the Federal Ministry of Education, Science and Research.

According to §§ 57-61 Studienförderungsgesetz 1992 (StudFG), BGBl Nr 305/1992 idgF the JAM MUSIC LAB Private University announces merit scholarships for the academic year 2020/21:

### I. Who can apply?

Regular students of the JAM MUSIC LAB Private University for Jazz and Popular Music Vienna (JMLU) with examination results between 1.10.2020 and 30.9.2021.

### II. Prerequisites

1. Compliance with the scheduled standard period of study plus one additional semester. A longer period of study is only possible for good cause (§ 19 StudFG).<sup>1</sup>
2. **Grade point average** of not worse than 2.0 at JMLU in the period between 1.10.20 and 30.9.21.<sup>2</sup>
3. At least **four semesters** must have been actively studied in the case of Bachelor's studies, and at least **two semesters** must have been actively studied in the case of Master's studies, for which the merit scholarship is being applied for.
4. Application is also possible for those who completed their studies between 10/1/20 and 9/30/21.
5. Application is also possible if a leave of absence is in effect as of 10/1/21.

### III. Required proof of studies

Summary of all coursework completed during the period 10/1/20 through 9/30/21, if not already on file with JMLU. Courses that have been evaluated as "not sufficient" must also be submitted.

### IV. Selection Criteria

Applicants who meet the above examination requirements will be ranked according to the grade point average of all course examinations assessed in the program. Merit scholarships will be awarded based on ranking according to available funds.

<sup>1</sup> Important reasons are illness as evidenced by a specialist's certificate, pregnancy or any unforeseen or unavoidable event, if the student is not at fault or only has a minor degree of negligence.

<sup>2</sup> A score (ECTS points x grade) is calculated for each course; the sum of the scores from all courses divided by the sum of the ECTS points results in the grade average used here. Courses that have not been graded (e.g.: "attended") are not taken into account.

**V. Amount of the scholarship**

The merit scholarship amounts to a minimum of 750 euros and a maximum of 1,500 euros. The exact amount will be decided after receipt of all documents and according to the available funds.

**VI. Application Deadline**

Prerequisite is the timely submission of the completed application form and all required supporting documents. Incompletely submitted documents cannot be considered. There is no legal claim to the award of a merit scholarship.
